How can parents view and/or print their tax report information?

Step 1 - Log into their parent account in Fast Direct

Step 2 - Click on the Finance icon

Step 3 - In the left hand menu, click on the option for Tax Report

Step 4 - In the drop down for calendar year, choose the necessary year

Step 5 - Click Tax Year Printout

Step 6 - A new internet window will open with a tax report that they can print through their browser's print controls
